'Jungleraj' has returned to Bihar, claims BJP

NEW DELHI, AUG 12/ -/ The BJP alleged on Friday that "jungle raj" has returned to Bihar with the RJ D-J D(U) government assuming power in the state as it cited a string of murders and other crimes to attack the alliance. BJP spokesperson Sambit Patra said at a press conference that several people, including journalists, have been killed and a temple priest was beheaded since the two parties joined hands to form the government after the Janata Dal (United) snapped ties with the saffron party. He also cited cases of sexual assau It and the death of six persons in Chhapra after drinking spurious liquor. "Disorder is spreading in the state at a fast pace. It will not be an exaggeration to say that 'jungle raj' returns to Bihar," he said.

The BJP has associated the Rashtriya Janata Dal's rule in the state with 'jungle raj' (lawlessness). He claimed that the BJP's presence in the state government earlier worked as a restraining influence on crime even though the party did not have home or excise departments. Patra also attacked Bihar Deputy Chief Minister and RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav over his reported comments on his party's promise of providing 10 lakh jobs. The BJP leader said Yadav claimed that he was not the chief minister when asked about the promise. He should clarify about it, Patra said. The Billar deputy chief minister has asserted that his newly formed government will "deliver" on the promise of providing 10 lakh jobs that he had made while spearheading the RJD's campaign during the assembly elections in 2020. Nigerian held for duping Odisha man ofRs 30 lakh through honeytrap

BALASORE, AUG 12/ -/ The cyber wing of the Balasore district police in Odisha has arrested a Nigerian in New Delhi for allegedly extorting Rs 30 lakh from a man here through a honeytrap, a senior officer said on Friday.

The aecused was residing in Kishangarh area of the national capital and involved in duping people through fake social media accounts created by him in thenameof foreign women, Balasore Cyber Police Station's inspectorin-charge Mina Bindhani said. A mobile phone, a laptop and several SIM cards have been seized from possession of the Nigerian, the officer said. Based on a complaint lodged by the man in January this year that he was duped by a foreigner through a lioneytrap, the cyber police station personnel started the investigation, the officer said. The man alleged that he came in contact with a worn an from the UK through social media and then, exchanged messages. The lady had sent a huge amount ofgifts including gold biscuits, a precious watch and a cellphone. When the gifts reached Delhi airport, a person, who identified himself as a customs officer, asked him to give a duty to receive the gifts. Accordingly, he paid Rs 30 lakh in installments but did not receive the gifts, the police officer said quoting the complaint. The investigation revealed that the Nigerian duped the man of Rs 30 lakh through the fake social media account of a UK woman, the cyber police station IIC said.

The police seized the bank account in which the money was deposited by the man, and the accused was brought to Balasore on three-day transit remand, the officer said. He would be produced before the court of SDJM, Balasore. Further investigation is underway, the officer added. (PTI)

Ambitions soar in Bihar Cong post upheaval; MLAwrites to Sonia demanding cabinet berth

PATNA, AUG 12/-/The return of Mahagath bandhan to power in Bibar seems to have set personal ambitions soaring in the Congress which had been down in the dumps. Chhatrapati Yaday, the MLA from Khagaria Sadar, has shot off a letter to Congress high command. demanding that he be considered, by virtue of his caste, for a berth in the new cabinet headed by Chief Minister Nitish Kumar. "I have written a letter to Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi, formally requesting them to consider me since my induction into the cabinet will send a strong message among the OBCs, particularly, the Yadavs. Iam the only Yadav MLA from the party in Bihar," he told reporters. Yadav said he has also cited in the letter his pedigree. My late father Rajendra Prasad Yadav had served in the cabinet headed by three chief ministers, Bindesh wari Dubey, Bhagwat Jha Azad and Jagannath Mishra, he said. With the Left parties, which together have 16MLAs, deciding to support the government from outside, the 19-strong Congress is expected to get four ministerial berths, according to sources in the new ruling alliance. Bihar Pradesh Congress Committee president Madan Mohan Jha, however, maintained that the number and the names are both decided by the high command. We are waiting to hear from Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi. The cabinet, which at present comprises only the chief minister and RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav as his deputy, is due for expansion early next week. (PTI)

The saffron party has been allegedly making all out efforts to take

mileage from the presidential election and create an impression among the people of the state that Murmu, regarded as the 'daughter of the soil', could occupy the

highest post due to the efforts of Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

BJD too had fully backed Murmu. Mayurbhanj considered a strong hold of BJP from where the saffron candidates had won in six of the nine assembly seats in the district apart from the

Jharkhand forest dept kicks off save tree mission by tying Rakhis

RANCHI, AUG 12 / --/ Jharkhand forest department has initiated a unique campaign to save trees by tying Rakhis to them in around 1,000 forest villages across 24 districts of the state, a forest official said on Friday. The idea behind the campaign is to connect the villagers with environment emotionally and to protect the trees from illegal felling in their respective villages, the official said. Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (APCCF) Sanjiv Kumar kicked off the campaign from Arani village in Simdega district on Thursday. We ad planned to utilize the occasion of Raksha Bandhan, being celebrated on Thursday and Friday this year, for this campaign. However, due to incessant rains in many parts of the state it could not be implemented on large scale. We have decided to cover all the identified villages on Friday under the campaign and create awareness among the villagers that trees are keys to their survival and sustain ability, he told PTI. In Lohardaga district, forest officials and villagers led by divisional forest officer (DFO) Arvind Kumar celebrated the festival of Raksha Bandhan by tying Rakhis to trees at Maoist hit Kisku

We have to protect the trees for oxygen, good rainfall and healthy en viron ment, the Lohardaga DFO said. Sanjiv Kumar was the first to launch the drive of tying Rakhistotreein Dhan bad's Maoist hit Tundi block in 2005 when he was posted as divisional forest officer (DFO) of Dhanbad, Later, he introduced it in around 500 villages under various districts including East Singhbhum, Saraikela-Kharswan, Hazaribag, Koderma, those districts. The APCCF said it was decided to cover at least 1,000 villages under the mission this year across the state. From next year, it will be extended to more villages, he said. I have experienced that trees get protection and green cover increase where this campaign was launched. Trees could be saved by putting additional guards in forests, tightening monitoring or connecting the trees to people's sentiment or emotion. I have seen the third option works better. If villagers are emotionally attached to trees or environment, they will save them automatically, he said. (PTI)
